#### **Classroom Communication**

For smooth execution of teaching and learning process, there is a need for clear, concise and meaningful classroom communication.

It exists in three categories: Verbal, Nonverbal and written.

Students must be taught to communicate respectfully, especially in the classroom.

20% teacher and 80% student Communication helps students develop their speaking skills

**CLIL** (Content Language Integrated Learning)

#### **Good Communication Practices:**

- Use proper tone that is honest, choosing words that are suitable to the situation and non-inflammatory
- When listening, make eye contact and focus on the speaker
- Speak in turns, never interrupt the speaker. Teachers who model respect with their students have respectful classrooms because students learn how to communicate respectfully.

#### Teachers' Role

### 1) Repeat your messages in a different way

Effective communication requires using different techniques in communication. Consider using visual tools like a chart or a graph to help students remember. In lecture method, offer or show hand-outs that outline the points. Give the students something to do that reflects your idea. Repeat the information twice and give something for students to look at, hold, or do that will reinforce your message.

#### 2) Check for Understanding

A teacher should always check for understanding. Students can write down one sentence that summarizes what they think the lesson was about, or they can write a question they have about the lesson. A teacher should ask the student to repeat the main point.

#### 3) Nonverbal Communication

Everyone communicates nonverbally through facial expressions and gestures. Effective communication in the classroom requires careful use of these nonverbal cues (signs). A disapproving stare can work wonders on a student who is off task. A bright smile for a student who is having a bad day means more than he will ever reveal. Gestures and animated facial expressions also give weight and enthusiasm to what a teacher has to say. Students who see a teacher actively engaged in what she is teaching will be much more engaged themselves.

## 1. Watching a Video clip or picture

## 2. Use technology.

There is a multitude of technological resources you can use for improving student communication skills. Mobile voice recording apps and vocaroo.com

## 3. Reinforce active listening.

Communication isn't just about speaking; it's also about listening.

Teachers can help their students develop listening skills by reading a selection of text aloud, and then having the class discuss and reflect on the content.

Active listening also means listening to understand rather than reply. Encourage students to practice asking clarifying questions to understand the message.

## 4. Offer group presentations and assignments.

Team-building exercises can also help students sharpen both oral and written communication skills. Not only does it offer students the chance to work in small groups, thereby reducing some of the pressure, but it also gives them the opportunity to debate their opinions, take turns (Students follow etiquette of speech)

## 5. Ask open-ended questions.

Because they require more than a one- or two-word response, openended questions are vital for inspiring discussion and demonstrating that there are multiple ways to perceive and answer a question. "what did you like best about the song?" rather than simply "did you like the song?"


## 6. Use tasks and activities that foster critical thinking.

Another task-based method for improving student communication skills is through critical thinking exercises. These can be done verbally or through written assignments that give students the chance to answer questions creatively using their own words and expressions.

### 7. Find teachable moments.

Whatever the age group you are working with, maximize on the everyday happenings in the classroom environment. Allow the class to ask clarifying questions.




