Anwarul Uloom College, 11-3-918, New Mallepally, HYDERABAD, TELANGANA-500001 represented by its principal **Dr.MOHAMMED ABDUL RAZZAKH** (Hereinafter refer to as "AUC", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean & include its successors & assigns) being the party of second part PSCMRCET and AUC are Hereinafter, wherever the context so requires, individually referred to as "party" and collectively as "parties".

Whereas:

- A. PSCMRCET is engaged in service of engineering & technical education with college name referred as Potti Sriramulu Chalavadi Mallikarjunarao College Of Engineering & Technology in the city of Vijayawada.
- B. AUC is engaged in service of B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com UG Courses in English and Urdu medium, with the college name referred as Anwarul Uloom College, 11-3-918, New Mallepally, HYDERABAD, TELANGANA-500001

Objectives of MoU:

- A. To promote & enhance academic interest between PSCMRCET and AUC.
- B. To provide advice for implementation of quality of education between PSCMRCET and AUC.
- C. To promote research/continuing education activities between parties.

Technical areas of collaboration:

- A. A continuing quality improvement programme to improve quality of teaching staff in both parties.
- B. Providing academic interaction by delivering special lectures at both institutes on topics of relevance to modern industry.
- C. Provide necessary helps in organizing workshops, conferences and personality development programmes at both parties for enhancement of skills in respect of faculty, staff and students.
- D. Provides necessary support for establishment of video satellite link and assistance in development of E-classrooms, Lab, Curriculum, Establishment of research labs, training and placement, library etc. at both parties.
- E. To provide training programmes for Students & Staff.

Proposed modes of collaboration:

PSCMRCET and AUC proposed to collaborate through the following:

- A. Cooperation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interest.
- B. Any other appropriate mode of interest agreed upon between PSCMRCET and AUC.

A specific plan will be worked out by the parties depending upon availability of resources. A specific agreement will be entered in to for each activity.

Terms & conditions:

- A. The cost of development of infrastructure at both parties should be borne by themselves.

- V. For continuing education to teachers and students the financial arrangements will be made mutually agreed terms.
- C. For the visits related to advice & consultancy, travel and other expenses of faculty & staff shall be reimbursed by both the parties on mutually agreed terms.
- D. The faculty and students of both parties can use library facilities for a short time.
- E. Both parties agreed to help identify and invite the faculty members & researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
- F. This MoU may be amended, removed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time.
- G. Either party should have the right to terminate this MoU upon 60days prior writtennotice to the other Party.

Confidentiality:

- A. The PSCMRCET and AUCagreed to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the parties as being confidential which is obtained from either party or created during the performance of MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other party.
- B. The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data processed by either party before entering into this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

Duration of MOU:

This MOU unless extended by mutual written consent of the parties, shall expires in one year after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, in review the MOU shall be extended for another two years by mutual consent.

Force majeure:

Neither party shall be liable for any failure or delay in its performance due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, provided that it notifies the other party as soon as practicable and uses its best efforts to resume performance.

Indemnity:

Each party shall indemnify and keep indemnified, defend and hold harmless the other party and their respective officers, directors, employees (collectively the "indemnified persons") from and against any and all direct losses, claims, costs, liabilities, judgments, expenses or damages that the indemnified person may incur or suffer as a result of or arising out of breach of any representation made by it under this agreement.

Severability:

If any part or any provision of this MOU becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that part or provision shall be ineffective to the extent of invalidity or unenforceability without in any way affecting the validity or enforceability of the remaining parts of said provision of this MOU. The parties hereby agree to attempt to substitute any invalid or unenforceable provision with a valid or enforceable provision, which achieves to the greatest extent possible the economic, legal and commercial objectives of the invalid or unenforceable provision.

Assignment:

The parties to the agreement shall not assign or support to assign or otherwise deal with any of its rights and obligations hereunder without the prior written consent of the other party.

Waiver:

Failure of party to exercise promptly any option or right granted, or to require strict performance of any obligation herein imposed shall not be deemed to be a waiver of such rights or of the right to demand subsequent performance of any and all obligations herein imposed.

Amendments:

All changes and amendments to this agreement or to any attachment there to be valid only if made in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of both the parties.

Dispute resolution

In the event of any disputes, differences or controversies arises between the parties, hereto, out of, or in relation to or in connection with provisions of this MOU or any action taken hereunder, the parties hereto shall thoroughly explore all possibilities for an amicable settlement. In case the amicable settlement cannot be reached, disputes, differences or controversies shall be referred to sole arbitrator appointment with the mutual consent of both the parties in accordance with the provisions of the arbitration and conciliation Act-1996, and the venue of such arbitration shall be Vijayawada and the proceedings shall be conducted in English. The award of the arbitrator/arbitrary tribunal shall be final and binding on both the parties hereto.

Jurisdiction:

This agreement shall be governed and construed by and in accordance with the laws of India and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Vijayawada and Hyderabad.

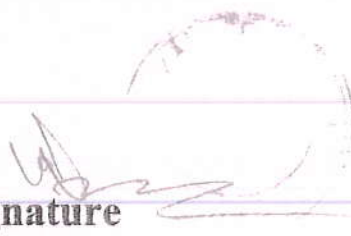





AND

GLOBAL MEDICAL EDUCATION AND RESEARCH FOUNDATION (GMERF), having a principal place of business at **GLOBAL TOWERS, 6-1-82/83, Lakdikapul, Hyderabad 500 004, India** (here in after referred to as "**GMERF**") which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to include its successors and assigns of the **SECOND PART**

For facilitating

COLLABORATIVE ACADEMIC, TRAINING AND RESEARCH PROGRAMS IN THE AREAS OF NUTRITION & DIETETICS.

THE ANWARUL ULOOM COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS), is established and administered by the Anwarul Uloom Educational Association (name of management) as an autonomous college under Osmania University Hyderabad.

THE COLLEGE had been benefiting from the expertise and facilities available at various National laboratories, academic institutes in and around Hyderabad through extension lectures, guest faculty appointments and training of students for project work.

GMERF is a not-for-profit organization having its own R & D and training centre which is recognized by Department of Scientific & Industrial Research (DSIR) pursuing research and training in the areas of modern medical biotechnology particularly applied in the areas of diagnostics and therapeutics.

In view of synergy in the objectives of the two organizations, it is desirable that THE COLLEGE and GMERF enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for making available the expertise and facilities existing in both the organizations for promoting training, academics and research in the fields of common interest within the framework of charter of both the institutions for an initial period of **3 years** beginning from the Academic year 2021.

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote co-operation, THE COLLEGE and GMERF enter into this formal statement of collaboration, for the purpose of collaboration in educational, research and training endeavors.

THE COLLEGE and GMERF have found it mutually beneficial to seriously explore co-operative activities for the following purpose.

1. Exchange of faculty and staff for teaching and / or research assignments.
2. Training of students in research through internships and research projects.
3. Organization of symposia, workshops and conferences.
4. Collaborative research programs.
5. Exchange of scientific and technical information & expertise.
6. Making the infrastructure available for collaborative research programs.
7. To design, develop and jointly offer short-term (6 months) certificate programs, PG diploma programs and elective courses in medical biotechnology areas for undergraduate and post graduate programs in various disciplines of biotechnology at GMERF.

The following terms of MOU:

1. THE COLLEGE will recognize GMERF as an institution for conducting research relating to the course requirements of the PG students.
2. To explore the possibility and establish jointly a finishing school (industrial training school) in medical biotechnology at GMERF for undergraduate and post graduate students of biotechnology.
3. The research scholars who would work at GMERF for Project/PhD thesis shall be governed by relevant rules and regulations of GMERF.
4. The course work requirement for the Ph.D degree program should be completed at Osmania/JNTU-H University. The GMERF scientists may be invited to deliver some lectures for PG programs.
5. The GMERF will provide the laboratory facilities for the Ph. D scholars admitted by THE COLLEGE under the MoU to carry mutually agreed upon research program. The number of such students will be based on GMERF's research agenda and availability of GMERF scientist's time to guide research scholars.
6. The approved GMERF scientist will provide the research supervision. Any publication/s resulting from the thesis research must be processed jointly by the scientists at GMERF and THE COLLEGE.
7. Whenever possible, GMERF and THE COLLEGE would encourage their scientists to deliver special lectures at each other's institutions.
8. Both the institutions will exchange scientific and technological information of value for their respective research and training programs.

9. Collaborative research projects will be proposed jointly by the two institutes to various national and international funding agencies in the areas of mutual interest involved in the faculty of THE COLLEGE and scientist of GMERF as investigators.
10. Short term training course, workshops etc., to impart training in various latest technologies will be conducted jointly by the THE COLLEGE and GMERF making use of infrastructure and expertise available at the two institutes.
11. GMERF will give preference to students of THE COLLEGE for any academic courses conducted by GMERF.
12. The terms of collaboration for any specific course or training programs will be added as Annexure to this MoU. The terms and conditions are liable for changes based on advisory board recommendations and will be applicable to this MoU.
13. **DISCLAIMER:** The parties do not intend this MoU to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise recognize a joint venture, agency, partnership, or formal business organization of any kind. Each party hereto shall act as an independent entity and neither shall act as an agent of either organization for other purposes.
14. **NON-EXCLUSIVITY:** The agreements reflected by the provisions of this MoU are non-exclusive in nature and both the parties can enter into cooperative arrangements with other parties to suit their organization needs.
15. **CONFIDENTIALITY:** The parties understand that in the course of their association, they shall have access to confidential information provided by the other party. Accordingly, the parties agree that such information shall be maintained in the strictest confidence and trust, except such information which is by nature, non-confidential or which is the public domain or which the party comes to know about other than through violation of any law or legal obligation, provided that such party may be entitled to disclose such information if legally required to be disclosed to a competent authority. Failure to maintain confidentiality shall entitle the affected party to terminate the MoU.
16. All disputes, differences and questions of any nature which at any time arise between the parties to this agreement or their respective representatives and assigns or any of them out of the construction of or concerning anything contained in or arising out of this agreement or as to the rights, duties or liabilities under it of the parties to it respectively or their respective representatives shall referred to arbitration under the arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory amendments or re enhancement thereto. The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Hyderabad, India.
17. Any party may by notice in writing to the other parties change the address and / or addresses to which such notices are to be delivered or made.
18. No amendment or modification of this agreement shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by all the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to

be an amendment of this agreement. The modifications / changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made or executed unless otherwise agreed to.

19. Court of jurisdiction for any dispute will be Hyderabad, India.

ARTICLE 1:

The output of these collaborative efforts may be used by either or both parties, with the recognition of each party's contribution.

The Principal, of THE COLLEGE and the Director, GMERF will be jointly responsible for working out operational details of the agreement between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of the MoU.

Both THE COLLEGE and GMERF may add, modify, amend or delete any part of this agreement by mutual consent and understanding of the signing authorities.


ARTICLE 2:

However, obligations and commitments already contracted for and involving third parties shall be honored and continued by both parties until such commitments are completed.





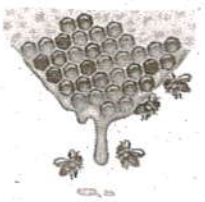
