The college is administered by Anwarul Uloom Educational Association, a registered educational society which was formed in 1909. The Degree College was established in the year 1953. The College is located in the heart of the city of Hyderabad on a campus spreading around 3 acres. There are numerous buildings accommodating Classrooms, Laboratories, Computer Labs, Libraries, Seminar Halls, Auditorium, Language Lab, Study Room, Alluring Garden and ample parking space. The college has a built area of 11, 550 sq. mtrs. The Vision and the Mission of the college is to provide quality education to economically and educationally deprived sections of the society. The college was recognized by the U.G.C in the year 1961 and was included under section 2(f) and 12(b) of the U.G.C. Act. The college was granted autonomous status by the U.G.C., State Government and the Osmania University in the year 1989 and since then the autonomous status is being extended from time to time. Anwarul Uloom College (Autonomous) introduced CBCS system in the year 2015-16 which has proved to be a major milestone in the Academic history of the college. Anwarul Uloom College (Autonomous) was assessed and accredited with 'A' grade by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore which is valid up to 2023. The college is presently offering 22 UG Programs, 12 PG Programs, and 29 PG Diploma, Diploma and Certificate Courses in Arts, Commerce, Science, Business Administration and Computer Applications. About 20% of the Students are from first generation background. Academic autonomy at the UG & PG level enables the faculty of the college to review and revise Curriculum according to the needs of the stakeholders. The introduction of innovative programs coupled with highly qualified faculty has enabled Anwarul Uloom College to achieve and maintain higher standards of teaching and learning. The college has the following distinctive features: Admissions: College has adapted online admission process for better convenience or seamlessness among students and faculty members. College has adopted Outcome-Based Education (OBE) system which is a student-centric where in the objectives of the course and the program outcomes are predetermined and teaching and learning processes and delivery is according to the set objectives and the students are assessed on the basis of predetermined outcomes. At the end of the program, feedbacks of the stakeholders are taken on the basis of objectives and after analyzing their feedbacks weaknesses are identified and suggestions are reflected while designing the course and the program for the ensuing year. Mentoring: The institute has adopted the mentoring system. The system was promptly and effectively put into practice with a wide diversity in students in regard to educational and economic background, the system promises to provide a better understanding of individual students and bring out their highest potential. Students are categorized based on the streams of studies and also according to their core subjects. They are divided into groups up to a maximum of 30. Each group is assigned to a Teacher-Mentor who would perform mentoring duties for the allotted group. Remedial Teaching for weak Students: Good care is taken by way of Remedial Teaching for Academically weak students. Many departments have organized remedial coaching for the students who need special care. Sometimes special classes are arranged during holidays. Grievance Redressal Cell: Any students/faculty member who has a complaint can ask for help and a senior teacher who forms a part of the GR cell advises and provides solution to the aggrieved. Results: College has impeccable results every year from all the streams. students have secured university and state-level ranks by gaining many medals and awards. Placement and Careers Counseling Cell: A unique characteristics of the college is that a majority of students get jobs in Middle East Countries. The reason being that a million of Hyderabadis are employed in the Gulf Countries and they

provide job assistance and guidance to their kith and kin in Hyderabad. In addition to this a good number of students get remunerative placements in and around Hyderabad City which is a hub of IT Industry in India. The College has an active cell for career counseling and placement assistance and guidance to the students for their career planning. Research, Innovation, Incubation centre: The College vehemently supports research scholars, innovations, and start-up ideas to encourage students by providing management training to nurture young firms. Faculty members of the college strive to encourage and brainstorm with students about millennial ideas that might have the potential to change the fabric of the market. Alumni contributions: We have a stalwart alumnus who has spread across the globe, representing our college. The alumni very often walk back to their institute for diverse supports. NCC Activities: The College has an active NCC unit with 200 boy and girl cadets. Rigorous training is given to the cadets of pass "B" and "C" certificate examination. NCC cadets also attend several prestigious camps, including Republic Day, National and Local Parades and camps among others. NSS Activities: The College has two NSS units and the activities are conducted under the direction of the NSS program officer.
