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





I. Welcome Speech by the Principal

The meeting commenced at 12 noon. The Principal of AU College welcomed all the members including the nominees of Osmania University. He presented report about the functioning of the college since last academic council meeting and enlightened the members of Academic Council about the various academic activities of the college. After the inaugural remarks, the items of the agenda were taken up.

2. Confirmation of the minutes of the last Academic Council meeting held on 29 December 2018 and the presentation of the Action taken report thereon :

The minutes of the Academic Council meeting held on 29th December, 2018 were circulated to all members. The minutes were approved and confirmed. The Action Taken Report on the recommendations of the Academic Council meeting held on 29th December, 2018 was readout and approved.

3. Approval of Almanac of the college (UG & PG) for the academic year 2019-20

The Almanac for 2019-2020 was presented. However Prof. Prashanta Atma, Head Department of Commerce, O.U. suggested that the Almanac shall be prepared in such a manner that the short vacations for U.G. and P.G. courses shall be common as it facilitates availing of vacations by the staff members teaching both U.G and P.G courses. The suggestion was found to be worth consideration and it was agreed to prepare the almanac accordingly. The revised almanac for the year 2019-20 is attached herewith (Annexure:A)

4. Approval of Recommendation of various Boards of Studies of all the Departments in the college:

Each Head of the Department through power point presentation, summarized the academic report of the department and the developments since the last academic council meeting were highlighted in the report.

A - Faculty of Arts

Department of English:- The Head of the Department of English presented the report on the curriculum changes in the syllabus of the M.A. post graduate course in English and also informed that there is proposal to conduct a national seminar and also to conduct a symposium and two days work shop.

Department of Hindi:

The Head of the informed about the approval of the syllabus by Board of Studies and the proposal of Introduction of diploma course in Hindi in 2019-2020, and the introduction of Hindi DTP course w.e.f. 2019-2020. However it was noticed that the approval of the Board of Studies is yet to be obtained. It was advised that only after approval of the course structure and other academic details by the Board of Studies, the proposal shall be presented in the next Academic Council meeting.

Department of Telugu:

The Head of the Department of Telugu informed about the approval of the syllabus by the Board of Studies and also informed about the Introduction of certificate and Diploma course in 2019-2020. He was also advised that only after approval of the course structure and other academic details by the Board of Studies, the proposal shall be presented in the next Academic Council meeting

Department of Urdu:

The Head of the Department informed that the syllabus of the undergraduate courses was approved by the Board of Studies and that there is a proposal to introduce Urdu DTP certificate course w.e.f. 2019-2020

B -Faculty of Business Administration

The Head Department of Business Administration presented the report of the Department. He informed that there is a persistent demand from the parents and students for the introduction of Bachelor of Business Management course. Accordingly the matter was discussed with the members of the BOS and after thorough academic consultations and discussions; the syllabus of the BBM was prepared and placed before the BOS. Certain changes have been suggested and hence the same will be further discussed in the next Board of Studies Meeting. Prof. C.Ganesh, Head Department of Sociology, O.U. enquired how this BBM course is different from the BBA course? It was clarified that the BBA course mostly deals with the Business Administration and leads to MBA course in post-graduation whereas the BBM course emphasizes on Business Management. Further a degree course with the nomenclature of BBM is being offered in various degree colleges under Osmania University jurisdiction.

C. Faculty of Commerce :

The Head Department of Commerce presented a brief report on the academic achievements of the Department of Commerce of the college. It was informed that the BOS have approved the syllabus for both the U.G. and P.G. programs. She also informed that a large number of commerce graduates pass out every year and are desirous of pursuing Post Graduate courses. Presently they have only one course M.Com. Hence it is proposed to introduce new courses at undergraduate level which are job oriented and in tune with the objectives of autonomy. Thus the Board of Studies in Commerce have approved the introduction of following new undergraduate and post graduate courses w.e.f. 2019-20.

Post-Graduate Courses:

- (1) Renaming of the existing M.Com. as M.Com. (Finance)
- (2) Introduction of M.Com. (Accounting)
- (3) Introduction of M.com (Information system)

Undergraduate Courses:

- 1) Introduction of B.Com (Computers) 3 YDC with an intake of 60
- 2) Introduction of B.Com (Taxation Practice and Procedure) 3 YDC with an intake of 60
- 3) Introduction of B.Com (Foreign Trade) 3 YDC with an intake of 60
- 4) Introduction of B.Com.(Advertisement & Sales Management & Promotions) 3 YDC with an Intake of 60.

D.Faculty of Science:

Department of Biotechnology:

The Head Department of Biotechnology presented the features of syllabus approved by the BOS for the U.G. and P.G. courses. The BOS have also approved introduction of a new section of 60 students with the combination of Biotechnology, Botany and Chemistry w.e.f. 2019-20. She also mentioned about the academic achievements of the department. The BOS has approved the introduction of six months certificate course in clinical Biochemistry to be introduced from the next academic year 2019-20.

Department of Botany :

The Head Department of Botany presented the notable features of the syllabus approved by the BOS for the U.G. and P.G. courses. She also submitted a brief report about the academic achievements of the staff and students. The department has got the approval of the BOS for introduction of (1) certificate course on E waste management from the academic year 2019-20. The department also proposes to organize an international conference on certain aspects of horticulture.

Department of Chemistry:

The Head Department of Chemistry spoke about the salient features of the syllabus approved by the BOS for the U.G. and P.G. courses. She also submitted a brief report about the academic achievements of the staff and students.

Department of Computer science:

The Head Department of Computer Science presented the notable features of the syllabus approved by the BOS for the computer science courses. He informed that one of the objectives of the Autonomy is to offer new courses which are beneficent to the students. Accordingly there is a big demand for the Computer Animation technology. Hence the department prepared a syllabus for B.Sc. 3 YDC in Animation and got it approved by the BOS for introduction from 2019-20.

Department of Computer science Engineering:

The Head Department of CSE presented the notable aspects of the syllabus approved by the BOS for the CSE course. He also submitted a brief report about the academic achievements of the staff and students. Prof C.Ganesh, Head Department of Sociology, O.U. advised that the department may offer a course in data science which presently is much in demand. He further suggested that the Department of Distance Education, Osmania University is offering a course in Data science and the necessary guidance of the Distance Education Department may be obtained if required.

Department of Electronics :

The Head Department of Electronics spoke about the broad features of the syllabus approved by the BOS of the Department. He submitted a brief report about the academic achievements of the staff and students. He informed that there is a proposal to conduct a work shop on ethical hacking.

Department of Mathematics:

The Head Department of Mathematics highlighted the changes in the syllabus as approved by the BOS of the Department. He submitted a brief report about the academic achievements of the staff and students.

Department of Micro biology:

The Head Department of Microbiology informed about the approval of syllabus by the BOS for the year 2019-20. He also submitted a brief report about the academic achievements of the staff and students. He informed that there is a proposal to introduce one year diploma in clinical pathology in future.

Department of Nutrition & Dietetics :

The Head Department of Nutrition & Dietetics presented the aspects of the syllabus as approved by the BOS for the U.G. and P.G. courses. She also submitted a brief report about the academic achievements of the staff and students. It was further informed that there is a need to introduce a degree course in Food Technology for the students of Biology, Physics and Chemistry stream students at degree level as it has a very good job potential. Accordingly the syllabus of the course was finalized involving experts in the field and finally the syllabus for the 3YDC in Food Technology has been got approved by the BOS for introduction of B.Sc (Food Science) 3 YDC with effect from the academic year 2019-20. Similarly there is demand for more P.G. seats in P.G. M.Sc. Nutrition course, hence it is proposed to add one more section of (40) students in M.Sc. Nutrition and Dietetics course w.e.f. 2019-20.

Department of Physics:

The Head Department of Physics informed that the syllabus has been revised and updated in the past several occasion and now there is no further scope for any more modifications and hence the same syllabus has been got approved by the BOS for the year 2019-20.

Department of Zoology:

The Head Department of Zoology submitted that the syllabus has been got approved by the BOS for the year 2019-20. A brief report on academic activities and notable features was also presented.

E.Faculty of Social Sciences :

Department of Economics :

The Head Department of Economics informed about the approval syllabus by the BOS for the U.G. and P.G. courses for the year 2019-20. He also informed that there is a proposal to introduce a diploma in public finance in future. The department also plans to conduct a national seminar on role of industries in Indian economy.

Department of History :

The Head Department of History informed about the approval syllabus by the BOS for the U.G. and P.G. courses for the year 2019-20. He also informed that there is proposal to enter in to MOU with department of tourism Telangana Government.

Department of Public Administration:

The Head Department of Public Administration informed about the approval syllabus by the BOS for the year 2019-20. She further informed that there is proposal to organize a symposium in Good Governance & , E- Governance in future.

Regarding the need to attract more students to the B.A. courses, it was suggested by Prof. Prshanta Atma and Prof. C.Ganesh and Prof. Sarla Devi that the Computer science subject be introduced as an elective in the 3rd year optional.

5. Approval of the Recommendations of Finance Committee.


Prof. Prashanta Atma and other university representatives opined that the recommendations of the Finance Committee need not be considered by the Academic Council. It was clarified that the recommendations of the Finance Committee are presented only for the information.

After the end of presentations by the Heads of Departments, Prof C.Ganesh of Osmania University desired that the college shall pay special attention to the following so that it maintains high academic standards and to aim for high grade in the next NAAC appraisal.

- 1) National level seminars and conferences shall be organized and the same shall be documented
- 2) Books publication, article publications in approved journals shall be ensured with documentation
- 3) Guest lectures by eminent persons of different fields shall be organized in and documented
- 4) Placement record of students with proper evidences shall be maintained.
- 5) Participation of teachers in national and international conferences shall be ensured with Valid Documentation
- 6) Outreach programs shall be ensured
- 7) Collaboration with industries, national bodies, professional bodies and international Universities with MOUS shall be ensured.
- 8) Consulting services shall be strengthened
- 9) Emphasis shall be on innovations and patenting of innovations.
- 10) Notable achievement and awards for teachers and students shall be documented
- 11) Funds from funding agencies shall be tapped after identifying them for research projects

The Principal and other members of the Academic Council expressed their sincere thanks and gratitude to Prof. C. Ganesh and other Professors of the University for their timely guidance and sincere concern for enhancement of academic standards of the college. After the above deliberations, the following resolutions were adopted:

- I. Resolved to approve the recommendations of Board of Studies of all the Departments of the college as summarized above .
 - II. Resolved to approve the Almanac with common short vacation for both U.G.& P.G. courses for the year 2019-20 .
 - III. Resolved to approve that the existing P.G.course M.Com. shall be named as M.Com. (Finance) and introduction of M.Com.(Accounting) and M.Com (Information System) With effect from 2019-2020 with an annual intake 40 candidates in each P.G.course . Also Resolved to introduce the following new undergraduate courses w.e.f. 2019-20
 - 1) Introduction of B.Com (Computers) 3 YDC with an intake of 60
 - 2) Introduction of B.Com (Taxation Practice and Procedure) 3 YDC with an intake of 60
 - 3) Introduction of B.Com (Foreign Trade) 3 YDC with an intake of 60
 - 4) Introduction of B.Com (Advertisement, Sales Management and Promotion) 3 YDC with an intake of 60
 - IV. Resolved to approve introduction of B.Sc. (Animation) 3 YDC course w.e.f 2019-2020 with an annual intake of 60 candidates.
 - V. Resolved to approve the introduction of B.Sc.(Food Science) 3 YDC w.e.f. 2019-20 with an annual intake of 60 candidates.
 - VI. Resolved to approve the introduction of additional section of M.Sc.(Nutrition and Dietetics) with an Annual intake of 40 candidates w.e.f. 2019-20 subject to approval of the University.
 - VII. Resolved to approve the introduction of a new combination in B.Sc.(Biotechnology, Botany, Chemistry) with an intake of 60 candidates each year w.e.f. 2019-20

Vijaya Govind, Head Department of Commerce thanked all the members of Academic council for making it convenient to attend the meeting and for expressing their valuable suggestions for academic excellence and assured that the same will be implemented with enthusiasm and zeal.
