#### I. Welcome Speech by the Principal:

Mr. Mazheruddin, Principal of Anwar Uloom College welcomed the Members and expressed pleasure that the nominees of the Osmania University, Viz., Prof. Dr. Mrs. Prashanatha Athma, Head Department of Commerce, and Prof. C. Ganesh Director, PGRRDC Osmania University have made it convenient to attend the same despite their busy schedule.

He presented his report about the functioning of the college since the last Academic Council Meeting and enlightened the members of the Academic Council about the various activities and academic achievements of the college. He stressed upon the need of team work, dedication in achieving the goals of academic excellence. He also expressed the untiring efforts put up by the management to keep the college par excellence. The target of the management is to achieve A+ in NACC Accreditation in future. Academic, Administrative Entities and Students have to work in tandem to achieve this target. After inaugural remarks agenda items were taken up for consideration.

# II. Confirmation of the Minutes of the last Academic Council meeting held on the April 29, 2019 and action taken report on the same:

The minutes of the meeting held on April 29, 2019 which were circulated already to all the members were approved and confirmed. Action taken report on the recommendations and suggestions of the last academic council meeting were apprised to the members.

The next item of the agenda i.e. Approval of recommendations of Board of Studies of all the Departments was taken up. Each Head of the Department through Power point presentation (Ppt) summarized the academic report of the department concerned as follows:

#### 1. Department of Arabic:

The Head of the Department presented the report of the department and informed that the faculty members have attended national seminar, workshops and Faculty development programme and in future she proposes to conduct workshop on Calligraphy.

#### 2. Department of English:

The Head of the Department presented report and informed that UG and PG syllabus has been approved by BoS for Academic year 2019-20. She also stated that the workshop in *Interview skills* was organized and Certificate and Diploma Courses in Communicative English and Soft

Skills are being conducted. The Department has also organized training programme for teachers of Kakatiya Vidyanikethan School. Their future plan is to organize workshop and conduct Seminar in collaboration with EFFLU and also to conduct IELTS in collaboration with Falcon Academy.

#### 3. Department of Hindi:

The Head of the Department presented brief report of the department and informed that syllabus has been approved by the BoS for Academic year 2019-20. The department has organized *Hindi Divas Celebrations*. Their future plans are to take up minor research project on "*Hindi Bhasha Ki Prati Protsahan*".

#### 4. Department of Telugu:

The Head of the Department presented brief report of the department and informed that certain changes have been made to the syllabus in I & II Semester which have been approved by the BOS.

#### 5. Department of Urdu:

The Head of the Department presented report of the department and informed that the syllabus has been approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. International seminar was attended by faculty member.

#### **Department of Business Administration:**

The Head of the Department presented report of the department and informed that the syllabus has been approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. He stated that he presented paper in International seminar and published paper in Scopus Indexed Journal. The department has collaborated with various industries and their future plan is to enter into MoU with ICSI and also to introduce BBM 3 Years Degree Programme in academic year 2020-21 for which approval will be sought in the next academic council meeting.

#### 6. Department of Commerce:

The HOD, Commerce briefed about the Courses and combinations being offered in her department and tremendous response for admissions into these courses. The BoS in Commerce has approved the modified syllabi of the various courses duly keeping in view the employability in the market for academic year 2019-20. She further informed that three faculty members have been awarded Ph.D. and one more thesis is under submission by a faculty member. So far 20 articles have been published in various approved journals. She further stated that faculty members attended national seminars and conferences and exchange of faculty with Vijayanagar College of Commerce has also taken place.

#### 7. Department of Biotechnology:

The Head of the Department presented brief report of the department and informed that certain changes in the syllabus have been made and the same is approved in the BoS. The Department is running diploma course in clinical biochemistry and organized one day International Seminar on "Biotechnology present and future". Faculty members have attended workshop on Bioinformatics tools organized by Women's College Kothi and also attended one day workshop on Research Methodology organized by DARE. Under future plan, department intends to restart Certificate Course in Medical Lab Technician.

#### 8. Department of Botany:

The Head of the department presented brief report and informed that the syllabus has been approved for 2019-20 by the BoS and have introduced new skill base courses "Diploma in Horticulture Techniques" The Department has collaborated with Nizam College and IOTA Labs for research work the future plan of the department is to organize a Conference on Horticultural aspects.

#### 9. Department of Chemistry:

The Head of the department presented brief report of the Department and informed that the syllabus has been approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. The department has organized and celebrated international year of periodic table. One faculty member has authored a book on *Medicinal Chemistry*. Under future plans, the department plans initiative in using Greener Methods in Lab and hands on training.

#### 10. Department of Computer Science:

The Head of the department presented brief report of the Department and informed that the syllabus has been approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. New topics are added in the syllabus to meet the current requirements of the IT Industry. The Department proposes to organize a seminar in the month of January, 2020 on the topic: "Cyber Crime and Awareness"

#### 11. Department of Computer Science & Engineering:

The Head of the Department presented a brief report on the activities of the department, Workshops & seminars were conducted. It was also informed that syllabus has been approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. The Department has published two research papers in International journals approved by the UGC. Under future plans department would like to introduce Python language, Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence etc.

#### 12. Department of Electronics:

The Head of the department presented brief report of the Department and informed that the Department has modified the syllabus and introduced advanced technologies in the field of

Digital Communication, Embedde System and Micro Processor and same has been approved by the BoS. The Department has collaborated with Physitech Electronics and Innovative Technologies. Under future plans, the department intends to start telecom course to increase the employability.

#### 13. Department of Microbiology:

The Head of the department presented brief report of the Department and informed that the syllabus has been approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. Faculty Members have attended International Workshop on "Extraction and detection of Mycotoxin from food Samples" and another workshop on Research Methodology Organized by the DARE. Under future plan Department intends to conduct Seminar on "Hospital Waste Management and Infection Control" and also workshop on "Molecular Techniques".

#### 14. Department of Mathematics:

The Head of the department presented brief report of the Department and informed that the syllabus has been modified and approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. The Department has organized and celebrated National Mathematics Day and would like to celebrate national Science day too. Under future plans, it intends to conduct Two Days National Conference on "Physical Interpretations and Inference tools in Physical and mathematical Sciences".

#### 15. Department of Nutrition and Dietetics:

The Head of the Department presented brief report of the department. It was informed that New Topics have been added in the PG Course and approved by the BoS for Academic Year 2019-20. The department has taken initiatives to promote and practice kitchen Gardening and organic Composting. The department has organized various activities in designated nutrition month and visited many hospitals. The Department has conducted mini project on Sprouting and Germination on Flax Seeds.

#### 16. Department of Physics:

The Head of the department presented brief report of the Department and informed that the syllabus has been approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. Faculty members attended national seminars and workshops.

#### 17. Department of Zoology:

The Head of the department presented brief report of the Department and informed that the syllabus has been modified and approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. Faculty members have attended seminars and workshops.

#### 18. Department of Economics:

The Head of the department presented brief report of the Department and informed that the syllabus has been modified and approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. Faculty members have attended National seminars and workshops. Under future plans department intends to introduce diploma in public finance, organize national seminar and major project on role of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Scheme (MGNRES) for Socio-Economic Development in Telangana State.

#### 19. Department of History:

The Head of the department presented brief report of the Department and informed that the syllabus has been modified and approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. Under future plans Department intends to enter in to a MoU with Tourism Department of Telangana.

#### 20. Department of Political Science:

The Head of the Department presented the report on the on the functioning of the department and informed that the syllabus has been modified and approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. Faculty members attended Electoral Verification Programme and two days National Seminar. The department has also taken up minor Research Project on the topic "Election Scenario in Hyderabad – A Case Study of Karwan Constituency".

#### 21. Department of Public Administration:

The Head of the Department presented the report on the developments in the department and informed that the syllabus has been modified and approved for 2019-20 by the BoS. Faculty members attended Electoral Verification Programme and Two Days National Seminar. The department has also taken up minor Research Project on the topic on "Allotment of Budget for Higher Education – A Comparative Study of the states of Telanaga and Andhra Pradesh". Under Future plan the department proposes to organize workshop and symposium on "Smart Governace, E. Governance and Good Governance"

#### 22. Placement Cell:

The Placement officer informed that they have registered with TASK and also other skill development consultancies and these agencies are organizing students skill training programmes and on campus and off campus placement drive conducted by SDL Manpower solution, Butterwoth consultancy services and Axis consultancy services. Placement Cell has also organized soft skill programmes and counselling and expert lectures on the techniques to face the interviews and personality development programmes. The cell also facilitated German language learning with collaboration with HUDA Consultancy. Under future plans, Cell intends to organize Placement Drive with Butterworth Consultancy and training programme through Alif Skill Academy and TASK.

#### 23. NCC:

The NCC Officer in his report on the activities of the NCC, highlighted their cadets' participation in various national level championships and achievements in Drill, Guard of Honour, NIAP, Ballet Dance, Group Song, Best Cadets and Best Firing Cadets etc. and also participated in Rock Climbing and trekking Camp. He further informed that under social service activities they organized rally on Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao, International day against Drug abuse, World Aids Day, Nukkud Natak on Social Evils, Swatch Bharat programmes and Haritha Haram programmes etc.

#### 24. NSS:

NSS officer reported that the NSS unit is involved in a wide range of activities. They have organized blood donation camps, and celebrated Yoga day, Independence Day, National Unity day and conducted AIDs awareness programmes, Swatch Bharath Programmes etc.

#### 25. Sports:

Director of Sports and Cultural Activities presented report on the activities of the Games and Sports and highlighterd the achievements and Laurels of the students in various events viz. wrestling, Judo, Karate, Kick Boxing, Football, Power Lifting, and Best Physiques competitions. Some of our students have participated at international level and won the medals.

#### Suggestion of Prof. Prashantha Athma:

She congratulated the college for being very supportive and for encouraging and allowing the lecturers to attend and participate in conferences, seminars, workshops, etc. every year and following suggestions were given:

- In view of the problems faced by the students in the day to day dealing with subjects and due to lack of soft skills while facing the interviews for jobs it is suggested to start PG diploma in English language and communication skills for UG and PG students on self financing basis which may include three classes per week.
- ICSSR are funding the organizations liberally for organizing seminars, workshops etc. it was suggested that the faculty members should utilize this facility for professional development.
- Osmania University is organizing shortly a seminar on practical application of tools and technology in research and suggested faculty members to participate for enriching the research knowledge.
- To teach ACCA to the undergraduate students in association with CIMA which will be much useful to students.
- 5. She also advised the faculty to focus on JRF offered by UGC and CSIR.

#### Suggestion of Prof. C. Ganesh:

In view of the latest developments in computer science, high demand and employability in emerging technologies He suggested to introduce PG Diploma Course in Data Science and Artificial Intelligence in this regard he suggested to utilize the expert services of Prof. Shameem Fatima, a former Principal of University college of Engineering, Prof. K Shamla, Prof. Sudha and Prof Ramchandran former Vice chancellor of Osmania University who have expertise in this field.
