Data Analysis Method: Data was collected online and analyzed with the help of count, percentage and average. Data analysis is presented with the help of tables and graphs.



**Chart 2: Students Feedback on Teachers** 



Chart 3: Year of Study



Chart 4: Students' Feedback on Course



**Chart 5: Overall Rating of the Student** 


