

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

Report on Jelly fish technology

Jelly fish is the Nature's most efficient swimmer – the "Aurelia aurita jelly fish", inspired by the shape & delicate movements of a jelly fish, which can explore the endangered coral reefs, a Robot was unveiled by British Scientists on Wednesday. Francesco Giorgio Serchi from University of Edinburg observed that in spite of lack of supportive skeletal structures; it does not prevent them from outstanding feats of swimming.

The Robot is the first submersible to demonstrate the benefits of using resonance. Its self propulsion system centers on a piston which strikes at the junction of head & the tentacles. When the piston hits at the ideal frequency, the robot is able to generate larger jets of water with very little energy. Because of this technology, the jelly fish robot can propel itself in a way that is 10-50 times more efficient than typical underwater vehicles preserved by propellers.

Because of these qualities the robot could replace divers in tasks too delicate for under water vehicles such as application of restoration substances to damaged corals.
