He welcomed all the members of Academic Council and expressed his gratitude to the external experts of Academic Council for making it convenient to attend the meeting. The Principal requested Mr. Ahmed Baig, Director of the college to take up the items of the agenda. Mr. Ahmed Baig in his address briefed the members about the notable achievements of the college since the last Academic Council meeting. He enlightened the council about A+ grade given by NAAC to the college and also about grant of further extension of Autonomous status by UGC and the Osmania university to the college for a period of another 10 years. He pointed out that during the current academic year 2023-24 there is considerable demand for admissions in the college. Keeping with the traditions of previous years, this year also the results for U.G. & P.G. programmes are outstanding. During the period under review the college has conducted Convocation and awarded Degrees & Gold Medals to the meritorious students, beside this students have participated in various National &

International sports and Inter-University events; N.C.C. activities & bagged many Silver, Gold Medals. Lastly he congratulated all the faculty members for their efforts in keeping the college in the forefront.

After opening remarks Agenda items are taken up for consideration.

## Agenda Item No. 2: Confirmation of the minutes of the last Academic Council meeting held on August 14, 2023 and Action taken report thereon.

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 14 August, 2023 and Action taken report was read out and approved by the council.

## Agenda Item No. 3: Approval of Recommendations of the Board of Studies of all the Departments.

Each Head of the Department presented Academic Report through PPT which is summarized below.

- Department of Arabic: HOD stated that the syllabus of Arabic for the Semester 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> has been modified. Board of Studies have approved the syllabus for the year 2023-24. It is further stated that Department is running (3) value added courses and Department has signed (3) MOU's which are operational and one research project of Department is under progress. It is further stated that, one faculty member has been conferred with best Teacher award during the year 2023-24. Another faculty member has been awarded Ph.D.
- 2. Department of English: HOD stated that the syllabus for Semester 1,2 & 6<sup>th</sup> for U.G. and Semester 2<sup>nd</sup> and Semester 4<sup>th</sup> syllabus for P.G. has been modified. BOS has approved the syllabus for the year 2023-24. It is further stated that Department is running two Diplomas and three Certificate courses. Faculty members have completed (3) minor research projects and published (4) articles in reputed journals. Besides this, the Department has organized (1) workshop, (2) Webinars, (1) FDP and also celebrated the Bharatiya Bhasha Divas. Future plans are to organize Seminars, Webinars, Workshops and undertake mini projects.

<u>Suggestions of Professor K. Arjun Rao:</u> (4) faculty members are holding Doctorates in the Department; therefore research projects should be taken up with proper funding from Internal & External Agencies including funding from management.

- 3. Department of Urdu: HOD stated that U.G. syllabus for semester 1<sup>st</sup>to 5<sup>th</sup> has been modified. BOS has approved the syllabus for the year 2023-24. It is further stated that Department has introduced Certificate course of In-page Urdu DTP and Certificate course in Calligraphy. Faculty members have published (5) research papers in U.G.C. approved Journals and published (2) books and organized (4) Seminars and (1) Webinar. Future plans are to organize more Seminars, Webinars and Workshops.
- Department of Hindi: HOD stated that syllabus for semester 1 to 6<sup>th</sup> for U.G. has been modified. BOS has approved the syllabus for the year 2023-24. It is stated that faculty members have been conferred (7) Awards. The Department has organized (1) Seminar, (2) Webinars. Faculty members have attended (1) FDP, (6) Seminars, and (6) Webinars.
- <u>Department of Telugu:</u> HOD stated that BOS has approved the U.G. syllabus for semester 1<sup>st</sup>to 4<sup>th</sup> for the year 2023-24. It is further stated that the Department is running Certificate Course in Telugu language.
- 6. Department of Commerce: HOD stated that in 5<sup>th</sup> semester of U.G. syllabus has been modified. The syllabus for U.G. & P.G. has been approved by the BOS for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that faculty members have published (3) Articles in reputed Journals. Future plans of the department is to start B.Com. Finance course and P.G. Diploma course in E-Commerce from 2024-25.

Suggestions of Professor K. Arjun Rao: Suggested to start separate course on Tally from next academic year as it has more job potential.

Department of Business Administration.: HOD stated that syllabus for B.B.A., B.B.M. for 5<sup>th</sup>& 6<sup>th</sup> semesters and B.B.A.(AI&DS) syllabus for 3<sup>rd</sup>& 4<sup>th</sup> semesters has been modified. BOS has approved the syllabus for the year 2023-24. It is further stated that the Department has conducted (2) Employability Programmes, (2) Seminars, and (1)

Webinar. Besides this, the faculty members have attended (2) FDP's, (2) Seminars, (2) Webinars and published (3) Research Articles and (2) Chapters are written for the Books published by Alpha International Publications.

- Department of Economics: HOD stated that the syllabus for semester 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> for U.G. has been modified & the syllabus has been approved by BOS for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that Department has organized (2) Webinars and faculty members have attended (2) FDP's, (2) Seminars and (2) Webinars.
- 9. Department of Political Science: HOD has stated that syllabus for semester 1st to 6<sup>th</sup> for U.G. has been modified. BOS has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that Department has organized (1) Seminar and faculty members have presented (2) papers in National Seminars and attended (1) FDP. The Department has conducted mock court sessions in the college and observed Vigilance week. The Department has entered into (3) MOU's which are operational. Future plans are to establish civic awareness club.
- 10. Department of Public Administration: HOD stated that syllabus for semester 1 to 6<sup>th</sup> for U.G. has been modified, BOS has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that faculty members have attended (1) seminar and (1) FDP, besides this they have presented (2) papers and organized (1) seminar. Department has also observed Constitution Day & Vigilance week. Department has also entered into (2) MOU's which are operational. Future plans of Department is to organize seminar on smart governance.
- 11. Department of History: HOD stated that syllabus for semester 1 to 6<sup>th</sup> has been modified and the syllabus has been approved by BOS for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that the Department has conducted awareness programme on Human Rights and it has organized (1) Webinar. Field trip to Bidar Fort, Karnataka was undertaken. Besides this, the Department has entered into (1) MOU and participated in Vigilance

awareness week. Future plans are to conduct Webinar on "Nizam rule (Salarjung reforms)."

Suggestions of Professor K. Arjun Rao & Professor Syeda Talath Sultana: They have made the following suggestions:

- 1. Professor Indra an expert on Modern History shall be invited as resource person for conducting Webinar on the "Nizam rule (Salarjung Reforms)" subject.
- After conclusion of field trip, students shall be requested to write report on the observations and analysis.
- 12. Department of Psychology: HOD stated that syllabus for semester 1 to 4<sup>th</sup> has been modified and BOS has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that faculty members have attended mental health awareness programme and they were invited as resource persons for guest lecture. Besides this the Department has also entered into (1) MOU.
- 13. Department of Mathematics: HOD stated that syllabus has been approved by BOS for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that the Department has conducted (1) Webinar and published (3) papers in reputed Journals. Besides this the Department has organized guest lecture and has also observed Ramanujan Day. Future plan is to start B.Sc. with Combination of Mathematics, Statistics & Computer Science and to organize FDP & Workshop on Data Science.
- 14. Department of Electronics: HOD stated that syllabus for semester 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> for U.G. has been upgraded & BOS has also approved the syllabus for the academic year 2023-24. It is stated that the Department has organized (1) Webinar and future plan is to start Certificate Course in Multisim.
- 15. Department of Chemistry: HOD stated that syllabus for semester 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> for U.G. and syllabus for semester 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> for P.G. has been modified. BOS has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2023-24. The Department has organized (2) Seminars and

faculty attended (2) FDP's & (3) Webinars. Faculty have published (3) papers in reputed Journals and (1) Minor Research Project is in progress. It is stated that faculty members have authored (4) chapters.

Suggestions of Professor D. Karuna Sagar: Following suggestions have been made.

.Instead of chapterization by the faculty members, suggested for authoring the Books & Publishing the same through international publishers as this will add value to the work of faculty.

16. **Department of Physics:** HOD stated that BOS has approved the syllabus for the year 2023-24.

Suggestions of Professor D. Karuna Sagar & Professor Syeda Talath Sultana: They have made the following suggestions

- 1. No improvement since last year, Department should take lead.
- 2. Suggested to observe Physics Day and Science Day.
- 17. **Department of Computer Science:** HOD stated that in semester 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> of U.G. course, topics have been added in the existing syllabus and the syllabus has been approved by BOS for the academic year 2023-24. It is stated that faculty members have published (1) Paper and edited (2) Chapters in the Book titled "Artificial Intelligence & Analytics", besides this (2) Faculty members have attended (1) FDP, organized (1) FDP and workshop for students of all streams. Department has also organized 15 days training programme for final year students in collaboration with Innovative Technologies, Hyderabad. Future plans are to introduce B.Sc. with combination of Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science and also to introduce Certificate Course in Machine Learning using Python.

#### Suggestions of Professor D. Karuna Sagar suggested the following:

- 2. Plan for Workshop on Machine Learning for faculty members.

- 18. Department of Computer Science & Engineering: HOD stated that syllabus updates are made in 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> semester and BOS has approved the syllabus for U.G. for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that faculty members have attended (1) Seminar/Webinar (6) FDP's have also been organized on the topic ChatGPT with hands on session and 2 days work shop on the topic Azure Machine Learning. Faculty members have authored (2) Books and published (3) Papers in reputed Journals.
- 19. Department of Botany: HOD stated that the P.G. syllabus for semester 1<sup>st</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> has been modified. BOS has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that the department has organized (1) Seminar, (1) Workshop, (1) Field Visit. Faculty members have attended training on Education Policy and (1) International Conference, besides this (2) papers have been published in reputed Journals. (2) Faculty members have been granted Excellence award. Future plans are to conduct Workshop on Bio-Reforms, introduce Certificate in Horticulture & Introduction of value-added courses in vertical gardening and hydroponics.
- 20. Department of Zoology: HOD stated that U.G. syllabus for semester 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> has been modified. BOS has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that the department has organized (1) Guest Lecture, (1) Seminar and (2) Educational visits. Besides this (1) faculty member has been conferred with Best Teacher Award and (11) Articles of faculty members have been published in reputed Journals.
- 21. Department of Bio-Technology: HOD stated that U.G. syllabus for 3<sup>rd</sup> semester and P.G. syllabus for 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> semesters have been modified. BOS has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that faculty member has attended a refresher course and another faculty member has made presentation in Conference. The department has organized (2) day Workshop on "Bio-Informatics Tools" for B.Sc. & M.Sc. students and (1) Research Project is under progress. Future plans are to organize

(1) International Seminar and to start (1) Additional Section of P.G. from next academic year.

- 22. Department of Microbiology: HOD stated that in U.G. syllabus for semester 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> and in P.G. syllabus for semester 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> modifications have been made. BOS has approved U.G. & P.G. syllabus for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that department has organized (1) Seminar and (2) Papers are presented by the faculty members. One faculty member has been conferred with Best Teacher award. It is stated that (4) Research Projects are under progress. Future plans are to organize (1) Seminar and (1) Guest Lecture on "Bio-Informatics beyond Genomics".
- 23. Department of Nutrition & Dietetics: HOD stated that BOS has approved the syllabus for U.G. & P.G. for the academic year 2023-24. It is further stated that in U.G. 1<sup>st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> semesters and in P.G. in 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> semesters, modifications has been made to the syllabus. It is further stated that the faculty members have participated in (2) Webinar, (3) FDPs, (3) Seminar, (4) Workshop and four faculty members have participated in (1) Symposium. The department has organized Nutrition Week and Health Camps in the college premises and made field visits to IHM, Vidyanagar. It is stated that many of the students are working as part time Dieticians in Hospitals and other Organizations. Three Projects are under progress. Future plans are to conduct Webinar, Seminars, FDP on clinical nutrition and also to engage in Research Activities.
