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**About the College:**

Anwarul Uloom College was established in August 1953 by the Anwarul Uloom Educational Association. Located in the heart of the city, the college is a prominent institution in Hyderabad. It was granted permanent affiliation by Osmania University in 1960 and recognized under Section 12f 2b of the UGC Act, 1956. In the academic year 1988-89, the institution was conferred first time autonomous status, which it continues to enjoying and in August 2023 UGC granted 10 years of autonomy to the college. Demonstrating its commitment to quality, the college was accredited with an A+ Grade by NAAC in 2023, becoming the first Muslim Minority Institution in Telangana to receive this recognition. The college is also certified with ISO 9001:2015 standards and actively participated in NIRF ranking and submit data to the AISHE on regular basis.
