














### 1. Bar Chart – Soft Skills Needing Development




### 2. Pie Chart – Career Destination Preference

Shows distribution of students' future plans.




### 3. Column Chart – Factors Influencing Career Decisions


**Graph Type:** Column Chart

Indicates what drives student decisions.




#### 4. Donut Chart – Preferred Areas for Future Guidance Sessions

### Seminar Sessions - I

#### Resume Presentation by Mr. Bharath

"The resume-building session was very informative, and I have already started revising my resume based on the tips provided."


## Conclusion




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
