- **Agenda Item No.1: Welcome Speech and progress report of the college:**

Mohammed Abdul Razzak, Principal and Chairman Academic Council welcomed the University representatives, the Deans of Faculty of Arts, Science and Social Sciences. He also welcomed the HODs and other members of the Academic Council. He presented a brief history of the college and the report about the developments in the college since the last academic council meeting. He detailed about college achievements and constant progress. The number of students who appeared for each course, the number of students who passed, and the pass percentage were presented in his report. He informed that the results were good in all courses and subjects. More Books as per new syllabus were added to the library. Placement and training cells got good placements. Sports facilities include both indoor and outdoor games like table tennis, badminton, chess, caroms, wrestling, judo, karate, cricket, etc. Students have participated in inter-college competitions and won several medals. Regarding the conduct of FDPs, seminars, webinars, symposiums, and other activities, all details are given in the reports of the departments.

After the report of the Principal, AUC, the items on the agenda were taken up:

- **Agenda Item No. 2: Confirmation of the minutes of the last Academic Council meeting held on October 26, 2024 and Action Taken Report thereon:**

Dr. Shaik Shafeequr Rahman, Vice Principal of the college presented the minutes of the 40th Academic Council Meeting held on October 26, 2024, and the action taken report thereon, which was approved by the Council.

- **Agenda Item No.3: Approval of the Recommendations of the Board of Studies of all the Departments:**

Each head of the department presented an academic report through PPT, which is summarized below:

1. **Department of Arabic:** HOD stated that the UG modified syllabus of Arabic for academic year 2024-25 was approved by the Board of Studies. She further stated that the faculty have participated in (42 national seminars, (4) webinars, (2) FDPs organized, (4) FDPs attended (8) workshops attended, and (2) guest lectures in the department. She also stated that the faculty of the department have presented (8) research papers in national seminars and published (2) research papers in UGC CARE-listed journals. She further informed that (3) value-added courses are offered, and the department has signed (4) MOUs, which are functional and (2) research projects completed by the department. Dr. Syeda Talath Sultana, Dean Faculty of Arts, Osmania University expressed her satisfaction with the working of the department and congratulated the department for their achievements.
2. **Department of English:** HOD stated that the UG & PG syllabus has been modified and the Board of Studies has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the department is running two diplomas and three certificate courses. Faculty members have completed (3) minor research projects and published (3) articles in reputed journals. Besides this, the department has organized (2) workshop, (1) FDP and also organized Literary Competition Week.
3. **Department of Hindi:** HOD stated that the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25 and organized and attended several seminars and webinars in the department.

4. **Department of Telugu:** HOD stated that BOS has approved the U.G. syllabus for academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the department has conducted literary competitions for students.
5. **Department of Urdu:** HOD stated that the U.G. syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the department has been offering Basic Urdu Learning Course & certificate courses, viz., In-page Urdu DTP and calligraphy. Faculty members have published five research papers in U.G.C. approved journals, organized one webinar, and won five awards at the national and international level.
6. **Department of Bio-Technology:** HOD stated that U.G. and P.G. syllabi have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2024-25. Future plans are to organize an international conference and a two-day workshop on CRISPR-Cas9.
7. **Department of Biomedical Sciences:** The HOD stated that the B.Sc. (Hons.) 4-year Biomedical Sciences program with chemistry combination is started from the academic year 2024-2025 across a few selected colleges in the Telangana State by the Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE). It is further stated that the syllabus of Bio-Medical Science is approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25, and he has been enlightened about the course details and employment opportunities. The Department has also organised a workshop on "From Sample to Diagnosis: A Hands-on training on Medical Lab Testing". The Department of Biomedical Sciences has also entered into Six MOUs with NSQ Pharma Pvt. Ltd., Saidabad, Hyderabad; Prof. G.M. Reddy Research Foundation, Swaroop Nagar, Uppal, Hyderabad; Germanten Hospitals, Attapur, Hyderabad; and Mahavir Hospital & Research Centre, AC Guard, Lakdikapul, Hyderabad; Redhill Diagnostic Centre, Red Hills Hyderabad; Krishna Western Multi-Speciality Hospital, Lakdikapul, Hyderabad. Future plans are visits to hospitals, pharmaceutical companies, diagnostics centres, research centres, incubation centres and conduct guest lectures, training programs and research.
8. **Department of Botany:** HOD stated that the UG & P.G. syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the department has organized (1) Seminar, (1) Workshop, (1) Field Visit and (1) guest lecture. Faculty members have attended refresher course, training on Education

Policy, workshop and (1) Conference, besides this (4) papers have been published in reputed Journals and authored (1) chapter in book (2) Faculty members have been granted Excellence award. Future plans are to initiating projects focused on plant conservation, bioremediation and plant-microbe interaction. Increasing opportunities for UG and PG students to participate in research Projects, Internships at different institutes like Institute of Forest Biodiversity, FCRI, etc.

9. **Department of Chemistry:** The HOD stated that the syllabi of UG and PG courses have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. The department has organized (2) seminars and (1) workshop and attended (2) FDPs and (5) webinars. Delivers (3) guest lectures, (2) research paper published in reputed journal, and (2) papers presented in national conferences and completed (1) research project. It is also stated that faculty members have authored four chapters.
10. **Department of Computer Science & Engineering:** The HOD stated that the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that faculty members have attended (4) seminars/webinars (17) FDP's and organized (1) FDP (2) workshops (1) guest lecture. Faculty members have authored (2) books and published (2) research papers in reputed journals. The Department of Computer Science & Engineering has also entered into four MOUs. Future plans are to introduce new course for the final year students i.e., Cyber Security and two Certificate courses a) Machine Learning b) Artificial Intelligence.
11. **Department of Computer Science:** The HOD stated that the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. It is stated that the Department has organized (1) seminar and (1) webinar. Future plans are to organize FDP on the topic "AI Tools for Microsoft Excel" and to introduce a certificate course in "Data Analytics using Microsoft-Power BI."
12. **Department of Electronics:** The HOD stated that the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies 2024-25. It is stated that the department has attended (1) FDP. Future plans are to conduct a workshop on applications of semiconductors in collaboration with the Dept. of Physics.
13. **Department of Mathematics:** The HOD stated that the UG & PG syllabi has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the Department has (2) Patents and attended (2) FDPs and (2) Seminars.

- 14. Department of Microbiology:** The HOD stated that the U.G. and P.G. syllabi have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the department has entered into (4) MoUs with industry and academia, organized (1) seminar, published (8) research papers in reputed journals, and presented (5) Research Papers/Poster Presentation & Abstract Submission, filed for (1) Indian Patent. One faculty member has been conferred with the Best Teacher award and the Best Oral Presentation award. It is also stated that five research projects are under progress and have attended a refresher course. Future plans are to organize a seminar on "Microbiome and Human Health." Guest Lectures on "Bioinformatics beyond Genomics," "Medicinal Plants with Anti-Cancer Properties," and "Pollution and Solutions" Industrial Visits FDP and to introduce one Certificate Course in Advanced Data Science for Life Sciences.
- 15. Department of Nutrition & Dietetics:** The HOD stated that the syllabi of UG and PG have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the faculty members have participated in (4) webinar, (5) FDPs. Future plans are to organize health camps, Industrial visit to National Institute of Nutrition Tarnaka, Hyderabad, Health talk on women hygiene and sanitation, to publish brochure on sustainable eating habits, to prepare poster presentations (3D), flash cards and power point presentations on diet counselling and research topics.
- 16. Department of Physics:** The HOD stated that the syllabi of UG have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. It is also stated that the department has organized (1) national seminar, (1) guest lecture, and attended (2) FDPs, (4) webinars, and (1) workshop. Future plans are to organize a workshop on "Quantum Computing" in collaboration with the Computer Science Department and a webinar on "Applications on Semiconductors" in collaboration with the Electronics Department.
- 17. Department of Zoology:** The HOD stated that the U.G. syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the department has published (11) research papers in UGC CARE-listed journals, organized industrial visits, and attended (1) FDP. Besides this, one (1) faculty member has been conferred with the Best Teacher Award.
- 18. Department of Business Administration:** The HOD stated that the syllabus for B.B.A., B.B.M. and B.B.A. (Artificial Intelligence & Data Science) has been

modified and approved by the Board of Studies. It is further stated that the department has organized (1) Seminar, (1) Webinar and, published (2) research papers.

19. **Department of Commerce:** The HOD stated that the syllabi of UG and PG have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that faculty members have published (07) research articles in reputed journals, (20) webinars attended, and (1) FDP organised.
20. **Department of Economics:** The HOD stated that the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the department has attended (2) Seminars and (1) Faculty Development Programme.
21. **Department of History:** The HOD stated that the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the members of the department have organized a Human Chain on Human Rights Day, attended one week FDP on Artificial Intelligence for Educators, organized one-week International Women's Day Celebration, attended a Webinar on "Cyber Hygiene for Women", organized by APTI Women Forum, also participated in Two-Day National Conference on "Political Consultancy in India: Opportunities and Challenges.
22. **Department of Political Science:** The HOD has stated that the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for 2024-25. It is further stated that one of the faculty members awarded Ph.D. The faculty members of the department have presented (5) papers in national seminars, published (1) research papers, attended (1) seminar & (1) FDP. The Department has entered into (2) MoUs, and **future plans are to establish a civic awareness club.**
23. **Department of Psychology:** The HOD stated that the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that the department has entered into (1) MoUs, an educational trip to Erragadda Mental Hospital. Future plans are to organize a seminar on solutions to depression, a webinar on emotional intelligence, and a visit to a counselling centre.
24. **Department of Public Administration:** The HOD stated that the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2024-25. It is further stated that faculty members have attended (1) Conference (2) seminar and (1) FDP and presented (1) research paper. The department has also entered into (3)

MOUs. The future plan of the department is to organize seminars on smart governance.

- **Agenda Item No. 4: Approval of the Almanac for UG Programmes I-VI Semesters for the academic year 2025-26.**

Almanac for the UG Programmes I-VI Semesters for the academic year 2024-25 was presented and approved.

- **Agenda Item No.5: Approval to follow Question Paper Pattern for PG 70/30 on par with Osmania University from the academic year 2024-25 onwards.**

Question Paper Pattern for PG 70/30 on par with Osmania University from the academic year 2025-26 onwards was presented and approved.

- **Agenda Item No. 6: Grant of one-time permission to candidates who could not complete degree in five years (3+2) in UG and four years (2+2) in PG for the academic year 2025-26.**

The grant of one-time permission to candidates who could not complete their UG and PG programs within the given time limit is to be provided a one-time opportunity to appear for their backlog examination. The proposal was approved.

➤ **General Observations:**

▪ **Prof. D. Karuna Sagar:**

He appreciated the Department of Arabic for its diverse activities and the research work carried out by the faculty. He commended the Department of History for designing a syllabus that enables students to score higher marks and supports their preparation for civil services examinations. Furthermore, he advised the Departments of English and Commerce to be more proactive. He also appreciated all other departments for their achievements and desired for further improvements.

▪ **Prof. Syeda Talath Sultana**

She observed that the research publications of the faculty members were not adequate and suggested that more publications should be encouraged. She also recommended that more faculty members should participate in and present papers at seminars, webinars, and other

programs organized by colleges affiliated with Osmania University. Additionally, she expressed the opinion that more seminars and workshops should be organized in the college. She however expressed her satisfaction with the overall development of the college.

▪ **Prof. C. Aruna Jyothi**

She appreciated the presentation of all HODs. She suggested the research papers should include issues related to women rights and Indian Constitution. She also suggested to organize more guest lectures on human rights.

After the discussions, the following resolutions are adopted:

- **Resolution-2:** Resolved to approve the recommendations made by Board of Studies of all the departments for the academic year 2024-25.
