- **Agenda Item No.1: Welcome Speech and Progress Report of the College:**

Mohammed Abdul Razzak, Principal and Chairman of the Academic Council extended a warm welcome to the University Representatives, Dean, Faculty of Science, Dean, Management and Business Administration, and Dean, Social Sciences along with the Heads of Departments and other esteemed members of the Academic Council. He presented a brief history of the college and highlighted the developments since the last academic council meeting.

He outlined the academic achievements and continuous progress of the institution. Programme-wise details regarding the number of students appeared, passed, and the pass percentage were presented. The Chairman informed that the results were satisfactory across all programmes and subjects. He further reported that books prescribed under the revised syllabus had been added to the library. The Placement and Training Cells recorded encouraging placement outcomes. The college provides facilities for both indoor and outdoor sports such as table tennis, badminton, chess, carroms, wrestling, judo, karate, cricket, and others. Students actively participated in inter-collegiate competitions and secured several medals.

After the report of the Principal, AUC, the items on the agenda were taken up:

- **Agenda Item No. 2: Confirmation of the Minutes of the Last Academic Council Meeting held on June 28, 2025 and Action Taken Report thereon:**

Dr. Shaik Shafeequr Rahman, Vice Principal of the college presented the minutes of the 41st Academic Council Meeting held on June 28, 2025, and the action taken report thereon, which was approved by the council.

- **Agenda Item No.3: Approval of the Recommendations of the Board of Studies of all the Departments:**

Each head of the department presented academic report through PPT, which is summarized below:

1. **Department of Arabic:** The HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified for the academic year 2025-26 and approved by the Board of Studies. She further stated that, the faculty have attended (2) international seminars (2) national seminars, (2) webinars (1) guest lecture (2) FDPs (4) workshops, and organised (1) seminar (2) webinars (2) FDPs (2) guest lecture. The faculty of the department have presented (4), and published (2) research papers. She further informed that (1) certificate course & (2) diploma courses are being offered. The department has signed (5) MOUs, which are all functional.
2. **Department of English:** HOD stated that, the UG & PG syllabus has been modified and the Board of Studies has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2025-26. The department is running (2) diplomas and (3) certificate courses, published (4) articles in reputed journals & presented (1) research paper. In addition to this, the department has organized (1) seminar, (4) FDPs (1) workshop, also organized International Literacy Day & attended (1) conference by the faculty members. Future plans are to organize a seminar on “Teaching Methodology” & publishing the research papers.
Suggestions: English modules developed by T.S.C.H.E are available online, may be utilized for students. Contemporary and practical components shall be incorporated into the syllabus.
3. **Department of Hindi:** HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified and the Board of Studies has approved the syllabus for the academic year 2025-26. The faculty members attended (1) FDP and received (3) awards. Also, presented a research paper

and received best paper award. The department organized literary competitions and planning to organize Kavi Sammelan.

Suggestions: The syllabus may be reoriented with greater emphasis on employability and skill development.

4. **Department of Telugu:** HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified for academic year 2025-26 was approved by the Board of Studies. He further stated that the faculty members attended (1) international seminars and presented a research paper.

Suggestions: The department is advised to compile a dictionary in Telugu focusing on the dialects of Telangana.

5. **Department of Urdu:** HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The faculty members published (1) research paper & edited a chapter in book. Department has also organised Literary Competitions, (1) seminar & All India Urdu Mushaira. Department also organised an educational trip to Salarjung Museum Urdu Library. Future plan is to organize seminar.

Suggestions: The department is encouraged to design and develop the college website and academic templates.

6. **Department of Bio-Technology:** HOD stated that, the U.G. and P.G. syllabi have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2025-26. Department organized (1) workshop (1) seminar (1) guest lecture. Faculty member presented & published (1) research paper. Future plans are to organize an international seminar, workshop on “Nano Biotechnology” and “an educational trip to National Institute of Animal Biotechnology”.

7. **Department of Biomedical Sciences:** HOD stated that, the syllabus of Bio-Medical Sciences has been approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The Department has organised (2) workshop (1) 11 days career readiness program and (2) educational trips. The department has signed (7) MOUs, which are all functional. Future plans are visits to hospitals, pharmaceutical companies, diagnostics centres, research, incubation centres, conduct guest lectures, training programs, diploma in hospitals & health care management.

8. **Department of Botany:** HOD stated that, the UG & P.G. syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2025-26. The department has organized (1) Workshop (1) Field Visit, and faculty members have attended (1) training

- program (1) international conference (1) workshop. Faculty members have been granted Excellence awards, have authored (1) book and published (2) research papers in reputed journals. Future plan is to introduce diploma course in horticulture, initiating projects.
9. **Department of Chemistry;** The HOD stated that the syllabi of UG and PG courses have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The department has organized (1) guest lecture, and faculty attended (1) seminar & published (3) research paper in reputed journal.
10. **Department of Computer Science & Engineering;** HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2025-26. The faculty members have attended (4) seminars/webinars (6) FDPs, and the department organized (1) seminar (2) workshops & signed (5) MOUs & runs (5) certificate courses. Future plans are to organise FDP, workshop & webinars on emerging technologies.
11. **Department of Computer Science;** The HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The Department has organised (1) workshop (1) seminar, and attended (6) FDPs & (2) workshops by the faculty members. Department also signed (2) MOUs and published (1) research paper. Future plans are to organize FDP on the topic "AI powered web development tools.", and to introduce a certificate course in "Advanced MS-Excel using tools".
- Suggestions:** Faculty members are encouraged to obtain A.W.S certification for Cloud Computing.
12. **Department of Electronics;** The HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies 2025-26. It is stated that the faculty member has attended (2) FDPs. The department signed (1) MOU. Future plan is to introduce certificate course on mobile phone repairing.
13. **Department of Mathematics;** The HOD stated that, the UG & PG syllabi has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. Faculty members published (1) research paper, attended (2) FDPs, (2) seminars & (1) workshop. Future plan is to organize a seminar on mathematical methods in physics in collaboration with physics department, also to conduct workshops & webinars on emerging trends.
14. **Department of Microbiology;** The HOD stated that, the U.G. and P.G. syllabi have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for academic year 2025-26. The

department has signed (5) MoUs with industry and academia, organized (1) workshop, (1) International Hybrid Conference, (1) educational trip to CSIR, published (3) research papers in reputed journals, and presented (6) Research Papers. Two faculty members attended International Conference. Future plans are to organize seminars, guest lectures, industrial visits, FDPs, workshops and training programmes. Department is also planning to introduce PG Diploma in “Good Laboratory Practices in Good Manufacturing practices in Food & Pharmaceutical Industries”.

15. **Department of Nutrition & Dietetics:** The HOD stated that, the syllabi of UG and PG approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. It is further stated that the department has organised Nutrition week, (1) workshop (2) educational trips & published (2) research papers. Also, faculty members participated in (2) conferences, (1) webinar, (1) workshop & (1) FDPs. The department has signed (3) MOUs, which are all functional. Future plans are to introduce value added course, organise FDP, educational trips, industrial visits & prepare audio-visual aid for nutrition education.
16. **Department of Physics:** The HOD stated that, the syllabi have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. It is also stated that the faculty attended (1) FDPs, (1) seminars, and (1) international conference & published (1) research paper. Future plans are to organize a seminar on Mathematical Methods in Physics in collaboration with Mathematics Department.
17. **Department of Zoology:** The HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The department has published (2) research papers in reputed journals, organized (1) educational trip, and attended (1) FDP (1) workshop. In addition to this, department signed (6) MOUs which are all functional.
18. **Department of Business Administration:** The HOD stated that, the syllabus for B.B.A., B.B.M. and B.B.A. (Artificial Intelligence & Data Science) has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The department has organized (1) webinar and published (5) research papers. The faculty members attended (2) FDPs (3) seminars & (1) webinar. The department also offers (3) certificate courses. Future plans are to organise industrial visits, guest lectures, seminars & webinars on emerging trends on business, AI & Data Analytics,
19. **Department of Commerce:** The HOD stated that, the syllabi of UG and PG have been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The department has organised (1) one week FDP (2) seminars & (1) webinar. Faculty

The department has organised (1) guest lecture (1) educational trip to Rashtrapati Nilayam, and signed (1) MOU. Faculty member attended (1) FDP & (1) webinar. Future Plan is to organise seminar.

21. Department of History: The HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The department organised (1) webinar & the faculty attended (1) Three Days National Seminar, presented and published (1) research paper. The department conducted various competitions for students on the occasion of Vigilance Awareness Week, 2025. The department also organised historical trip to Salarjung Museum & educational trip to Rashtrapati Nilayam. Future plans are to organise historical trip, webinars & seminars.

Suggestions: Relevant content from the book '21 Lessons for the 21st Century' may be incorporated into the syllabus.

22. Department of Political Science: The HOD has stated that, the syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for 2025-26. The faculty member of the department presented (1) paper, published (2) research papers, attended (3) seminars & (1) conference. The Department has signed (1) MoUs & (1) faculty qualified UGC-NET. The department has also organised educational trip to Rashtrapati Nilayam & conducted literary competitions as a part of Vigilance Awareness Week. Future plan is to organise seminar on “One Nation-One Election and Indian Federalism”.

23. Department of Psychology: The HOD stated that, the syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The department has signed (1) MoU, & organised (1) workshop (1) educational trip to Institute of Mental Health Center (Erragadda). Future plans are to organize seminars and webinars for growth & expansion.

Suggestions: Cognitive Psychology may be included in the syllabus.

24. Department of Public Administration: The HOD stated that, the UG syllabus has been modified and approved by the Board of Studies for the academic year 2025-26. The department has organised an awareness campaign on constitution day, vigilance

awareness week, educational trip to Rashtriya Nilayam & signed (1) MOU. The faculty members attended (2) seminars and, (1) FDP. The future plan of the department is to organize seminars on “role of public administration in digital era”.

Suggestions: Campus Recruitment topic in syllabus, may be reviewed and restructured.

- **Agenda Item No. 4: Report of Sports Department**

The Director of Sports presented the report which appreciated the achievements and performance of the students.

- **Agenda Item No. 5: Report of NCC & NSS Department**

- The Academic Council noted and appreciated the achievements of the students in NCC and NSS activities.

Suggestion: Efforts be intensified to increase the percentage of ‘A’ Certificate holders, as it would enhance students’ prospects for employment and higher opportunities.

- **Agenda Item No. 6: Ratification of the Almanac for PG Programmes I-IV Semesters for the academic year 2025-26**

Almanac for the PG Programmes I-IV Semesters for the academic year 2025-26 was presented and approved.

- **Agenda Item No.7: Conduct of Instant/Advanced Supplementary Examinations for those regular final year students who appeared and failed only in 6th semester for the academic year 2025-26**

The matter was discussed and agreed to conduct Instant/Advanced Supplementary Examinations / make-up examinations for those regular final year students who appeared and failed in 6th semester examinations either in theory or practical papers.

The proposal was approved.

- **Agenda Item No. 8: Online Evaluation for all semester of UG & PG from the academic year 2025-26 onwards**

The Academic Council approved the implementation of Online Evaluation for all semesters of Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes with effect from the academic year 2025–26.

Suggestions made by Prof. B. Sudhakar Reddy, Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences:

1. Proper and effective checks and balances shall be incorporated into the examination and evaluation system to maintain academic integrity and quality assurance.
2. While awarding grace marks, ensure that provisions are applied in accordance with prescribed norms.

3. Necessary measures shall be taken to improve pass percentages in programmes where the percentage is comparatively low.
 4. Efforts shall be intensified to improve overall student placements in the college through enhanced career guidance, training, and industry linkage initiatives.
 5. All departments are advised to strictly adhere to the norms and guidelines prescribed by the UGC and the affiliating University while organizing and participating in national and international seminars, conferences, workshops, and related academic activities.
 6. Departments are encouraged to tap Government funding agencies to enhance the quality and impact of academic and research initiatives.
 7. The objectives and academic utility of seminars, workshops, and similar programmes should be clearly defined and articulated.
 8. Faculty members of the departments should also derive academic benefit from seminars and academic activities; hence, internal abstract presentations may be organized to enrich faculty knowledge, enhance motivation, and avoid duplication of work across departments.
 9. Research publications should be made in credible, standard, and recognized journals.
 10. Citations used in research publications must be duly verified through authentic and reliable sources.
 11. Faculty members are encouraged to obtain memberships of reputed academic and research databases such as Scopus, Vidwan, and similar platforms.
 12. Departments are advised to enter into Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) instead of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), as MoAs are easier to implement and offer a wider scope for collaboration.
- **Prof. D. Sriramulu, Dean Faculty of Management & Business Administration**, he appreciated the efforts of the institution for its academic progress, student achievements, and overall development.
